


“CLAWS” *Struthiomimus sedens*

This *Struthiomimus sedens* skeleton, the most complete excavated to date, is the only free mount reconstruction of this dinosaur presently available. Obviously built to travel at high speeds, we often mount our *Struthiomimus* skeletons in a “dead run” pose, pushing off on one foot. The steel support structure hidden throughout the skeleton is virtually invisible. Constructed modularly with simplicity in mind, this mount can be assembled by one person in under an hour! When packed in a custom-made, reusable crate, it’s easily transported to off-site locations for outreach programs, promotional opportunities, etc.

The *in situ* death pose display shows the skeleton lying in the matrix as originally excavated (some areas restored), which makes for an excellent children’s dig exhibit. (*in situ*: 92” x 45” - 2.4 m x 1.2 m)

Other replica items available from CLAWS

- Arm, Foot, Hand, Hand Claw, Foot Claw, Skull, Femur

The specimen is nicknamed CLAWS due to three wickedly long, sharp claws on each of this dinosaur’s hands - equipment which seems quite capable of catching, holding and shredding prey.
